Serving as president from 1996 to 2023, she became the longest-serving president in the organization's history. Poitras' leadership focused on advancing the rights, recognition, and well-being of the Métis people in Alberta. Under her leadership, the MNA achieved significant milestones, including negotiating land claims, enhancing Métis education and health services.
